Have you ever done anything to promote your skills and / or experiences? This can vary widely from learning a new language through Rosetta Stone to make a class of Adobe Photoshop. Talk about why you care about promoting your knowledge and set of skill .7. What is your greatest force? There are innumer positive responses that you can answer. Do not attack 20 different positive qualities, stay with some and expand in them. Try and relieve it to position. Are they looking for a good staff official? Do they need someone who is extremely meticulous? Keep which qualities they are looking for in mind when selecting yours. My favorite is; Results-oriented.8. What is your biggest weakness? This is quite complicated. The most common things that interviewees are positive in a negative. Tell me about once you did a suggestion that was implemented? Think of a real suggestion that you did it this results. Be very detailed. Do not just say that my idea had positive results, talk about how sales rose 26% in the next three months, for example, .13. How do you deal with pressure or stress at work? You work hard under pressure and stress.14. Have you ever had problems with previous employers? This is a trick question. They are testing you to see if you would talk bad about an employer / colleague. Say "no" 15. In terms of salary, what are you looking for? This issue really depends on the work environment of the work you are going. In some, you should give your number and others, they hope you are more educated. If they seem to want an answer, give a wide variety. And, do not forget to find the multi-day salary track for this online position? You are one or the other. Explain your character's strengths that show you can compensate. Try to tie so many related experiences as possible to the work you want. It sounds confident that you could be the best at work. If you are superalified, talk about why you are in love with the position and the company. Discuss your paixions for the position and why you feel like work is really a perfect fit.17 How would you know if you succeeded in your work? Mention something like, if the customer / your boss was happy with your work. Talk about the goals you would define and try to find yourself. They just want to know that you are not a sensitive Whiner.20. If you hired, how long would you expect to work for us? Do not give them a real-time line unless you really want to divulge it. Say something genius as "while the employer feels that I am doing a good job." 21 What motivates you do a good job? No, it's not money. (Even if it is!) Try something like "become better than I do," "learn something new," or "feel good about a well-done job." 22 Tell me about a professional disappointment. Attured about a real situation and how you dealt with it. It is not negative because they all had a professional disappointment.23. Have you ever learned from a mistake you did at work? Talk about an error and what you learned. Make sure that the error is not something dramatic. Be sure to emphasize the lesson learned and how your behavior changed from it! 24. Tell me about the most fun you had in a job. That's right. Describe something you have amused doing, as doing a huge design or landing a big name customer. 25. What is your dream job? Be honest here. Especially if the work is non-entry or medical level. They are aware that you do not want to be an assistant for the rest of your life! However, if you are going to a high level position, be cautious. No company wants to hire someone who does not like to do what they do.26. How would you describe your work is? They are simply trying to evaluate your lazy gauge. Be confident and respond "It's great!" 27. Do you know anyone who works for this company? This is complicated. If someone referred you or whether it is a family member, you will obviously not lie. However, be cautious in mentioning a lot of friends that you know, if your employer does not have a warm impression of them. 28. Are you comfortable. Ask about the reimbursement of Gás. 29. Were you willing to work overtime? Night and weekends? Be honest here too, already you will have to work these hours .30. Do you have any questions for me? Yes!
