## Snoop ice cube too short

West Coast legends Snoop Dogg, Ice Cube, Too Short, and E-40 have joined forces as Mt. Westmore and are set to release an album together in April. “We have recorded somewhere in the neighborhood of 50 songs. Volume 1 will be released in April and the rest of the volumes will follow,” Too Short revealed in a recent DJ Vlad interview. “At the age we’re at is a good time to do a thing like this and kind of extend your career a bit in a different way... The minute we join forces, we get a handful of new business opportunities that none of us would’ve had.” Too Short continued by saying the supergroup was a natural extension of the sold-out shows they’ve done together in the past, adding he wanted it to serve as an example for the current and future generations to prolong their careers.As HipHop-N-More points out, Too Short first revealed the quarantine project on fellow veteran rapper MC Serch’s podcast back in December when he said, “I get a call during the early part of the quarantine from E-40 and Ice Cube going, ‘Man, we feel like we should do an album. Me, you, it’s E-40, Cube, Too Short and Snoop Dogg.’ And I’m like... ‘E-40 and Too Short are from the Bay, Snoop Dogg and Cube are from L.A. and we are like the West Coast foundation.’ We sat there and was like, ‘Fuck it, let’s do it.’ So, we start coming up with beats.” In a February interview with HipHopDX, Too Short and E-40 revealed Dr. Dre will be the only feature on the project. Too Short also revealed how each member critiqued each other’s verses. “We gave each other the authority to criticize, critique, veto, make suggestions, and just everything is like hands-down, I trust what you saying. It literally has been said, ‘Bro, that verse you spit yesterday was wack,’ and then bro go back and redo that verse, and like, ‘You came with it this time.’” Mt. Westmore will make their live debut next month at the 2021 Fight Club pay-per-view being held by Triller, the entertainment platform with which Snoop Dogg is a partner. YouTube influencer and boxer Jake Paul is in the headline match, and other performers on the show include Justin Bieber, The Black Keys, Doja Cat, Saweetie, and Major Lazer.E-40 and Too Short recently teamed up for a joint album of their own, Ain’t Gone Do It / Terms and Conditions, in December 2020. Meanwhile, Cube last released 2018’s Everything’s Corrupt and Snoop dropped I Wanna Thank Me in 2019. The debut album from the group lands in April Thursday, March 18, 2021 - 12:52 Snoop Dogg, Ice Cube, Too Short, and E-40 have formed a new hip-hop supergroup.Dubbed Mt. Westmore, the supergroup of West Coast rappers was first revealed last year on the Serch Says podcast by Too Short, who became involved in the project after a phonecall during lockdown from E-40 and Ice Cube. “So I get a call during the early part of the quarantine from E-40 and Ice Cube going, ‘Man, we feel like we should do an album. Me, you, it’s E-40, Cube, Too Short and Snoop Dogg,’” he told MC Serch. “And I’m like... Westmore. On Tuesday, Too Short joined DJ Vlad on VladTV where he revealed that the four rappers have already recorded “somewhere in the neighborhood of 50 songs” and will release their debut album next month. Too Short also noted that additional “volumes” will be released in the future. He said: It’s not a thing that we dreamed up; it is a thing that’s really real. This is serious and we did this because we wanted to do some business ventures together and we wanted to join forces to future four together as well as release these projects... The set was laid out perfectly on Saturday night (April 17) for the debut of the Mount Rushmore supergroup at Triller’s Jake Paul versus Ben Askren fight — palm trees, bright lights and a coronavirus-safe stage. To kick off the performance, Ice Cube walks out to his 1992 hit song “Today Was A Good Day” and starts rapping the first verse, his signature snarl in full effect. From there, he explodes into 1999’s “You Can Do It.” Snoop Dogg then takes the stage with songs such as the 1993 classic “Gin & Juice” and 2004’s “Drop It Like It’s Hot.” As Snoop wraps up his solo set, the lights goes down and when they come back up, Ice Cube, Too Short, E-40 and Snoop Dogg are found lounging in four regal-looking chairs. Armed with a bass-heavy Kato On The Track beat, Mount Rushmore immediately reminds their audience what makes them OGs. E-40 takes the mic first as Snoop Dogg provides some well placed ad-libs before he bursts into his verse. Short Dog comes in with an unsurprisingly raunchy 16 before shouting, “Bitch!” as Cube brings it home with lines such as, “It’s a new day/Still got the AK,” a clear reference to “Today Was A Good Day.” HipHopDX broke the news Snoop Dogg, Too Short, Ice Cube and E-40 had formed the supergroup last December after obtaining an exclusive clip from MC Serch featuring an interview with Short. “During the quarantine, I got a call from Ice Cube and E-40,” Short told Serch during a conversation for his Serch Says podcast. “Over the years, probably more than the past five years, we’ve been doing kind of these old school concerts. It will be either Snoop Dogg or Ice Cube headlining, or it will be me, E-40, sometimes it’s Bone Thugs, DJ Quik. They usually call it like ‘How The West Was Won,’ ‘West Coast Kings’ or some shit like that and it’s always a big show and it always sells out. Speaking of quarantine, on December 19, 2020, E-40 and Too Short actually went head-to-head in a Verzuz battle, taking turns playing their legendary hits. Before, the battle, both artists had released solo albums and packaged them as a bundle of 20 total tracks. Too Short released his album Ain’t Gone Do It and E-40 released Terms & Conditions. According to BET, Too Short also revealed in an interview with HipHopDX that Dr. Dre is going to be a part of the album. Dr. Dre is the album’s only feature and he’s already contributed. “He’s on there. Snoop got him on there. Dre is on there.” Too Short said. That’s Snoop’s guy. That’s Ice Cube’s guy.” We can’t wait to see what projects these hip-hop legends have in store for fans! Music - 3 months ago Late last year, Too Short and E-40 announced they had formed a rap supergroup with fellow West Coast rap legends, Snoop Dogg and Ice Cube. Originally mentioned somewhat in passing during their interview with The Breakfast Club, the concept for Mt. Westmore is just as the name implies: a collaborative outing from (arguably) the most influential West Coast rappers in history. But it appears the group was more than just a fleeting thought. According to Short, Mt. Westmore has already recorded dozens of songs together and is prepping the first “volume” of their work. “It’s not a thing we dreamed up. It’s a thing that is really real. We have recorded somewhere in the neighborhood of 50 songs,” the Oakland rapper said in a recent chat with VladTV (see below.) “Volume One will be released in April,” he added before noting the joint project was a logical next step after years of performing on different bills together. The arrival of the supergroup’s debut album will likely line up with their first live performance, currently set for April 17th at Triller’s next Fight Club event, where they’ll share the marquee with Doja Cat, Justin Bieber, The Black Keys, Saweetie, Diplo and Major Lazer. The four-hour pay-per-view event will cap with a fight between (actual) boxer, Ben Askren, and YouTube-star-turned-boxer, Jake Paul, who notoriously knocked out the NBA’s Nate Robinson in Triller’s previous boxing event. You can buy a “ticket” to the next fight here. A precise release date for the Mt. Westmore album has yet to be announced. But it shouldn’t be too long now. Watch Too Short detail the project below and hold tight for updates in the weeks and months ahead.
