Lonne-Hoffmann debunicates this myth: à € "In rare rare rareThe penis can completely cover the opening of the vagina. A maximum of one woman in 1,000 can suffer from this condition, in which menstrual blood cannot leave the body and must be operated on", she says.In almost all women, this mucous membrane is shaped like a ring. In other words, it has an opening. "The ring of hell comes in every conceivable shape. It can be round, shaped like a crescent or a band along the opening. All this is normal, unless it's completely closed, says Lonne-Hoffmann. The shape of the hormone in girls and women can vary greatly, regardless of whether they have had sex or not. At first the ring is very thin, but when the girls reach puberty it becomes both thicker and more elastic.For most women, it doesn't matter much.Chronic pain in the skinBut for some patients, that small piece of tissue creates physical problems.Women with an abdominal disorder, such as vulvodynia, often experience a strong specific pain in their stomachs, says the gynecologist. "Usually the vagina has few nerve endings in general. But in patients with vulvar disorders, the whole area has many nerve endings", he says.Lonne-Hoffmann also says that some women who have given birth look for a gynecologist to ask themselves what is between their inner lips.The hymenal ring labels are a consequence of extra hymenic tissue located at the outer entrance of the vagina. They can be of different sizes, but for some women these flaps can protrude several inches from the vagina. Å "Many women are surprised when they discover that it is their ring that sticks out. They thought it was polyps or warts", says Lonne-Hoffmann, who advises women who suffer from hymenic markings to leave them alone, unless they protrude several centimeters. Surgery can leave scars, which can create bigger problems.
