By Darrin Meyer FiOS, offered by Verizon in selected areas, is the subscription television service through fiber-optic cables, providing higher-quality video compared to standard cable. The channels and features available with FiOS rival those of the major cable and satellite TV providers, and among those features is the ability to access recorded FiOS programming from TVs in different rooms without adding additional DVRs, which is the receiver box required for multi-room viewing, as well as additional non-DVR set-top box(es) for each TV you wish to connect.
